## Youth receiving maltreatment-related intervention services were more likely to receive other government services than youth not receiving intervention services

6,400 12 to 17 year olds received maltreatment-related intervention services in Alberta in 2008/09.


Youth receiving intervention services were more likely to have offence charges or involvement with correctional services or with Family Support for Children with Disabilities (FSCD) than those who did not receive intervention services.

Enrolment in the education system did not vary with intervention status.
