
## Youth receiving maltreatment-related intervention services were more likely to have all types of mental health conditions than youth not receiving intervention services

25,442 Albertans 12 to 17 years of age received services for mental health conditions in 2008/09.

Service use for all mental health conditions was higher for youth who received maltreatmentrelated intervention services than for youth with no maltreatment-related intervention services.

The highest rates of mental health conditions were found for youth receiving in care services, followed by youth receiving out of care services.
