



Aboriginal Financial Scholarships 21st International Congress Calgary, Alberta – August 28 – 30, 2016

The International Society for the Prevention of Child Abuse and Neglect (ISPCAN) is holding the 21st International Congress in Calgary, Alberta from August 28 – 30, 2016 and will be hosted by the University of Calgary's Faculty of Social Work. This will provide an opportunity for participants to be a part of an international gathering of researchers and practitioners involved in the area of child abuse and neglect.

The organizing committee will be providing approximately 30 Aboriginal financial scholarships to support Aboriginal practitioners and students' participation in this conference. The scholarship can be applied to registration costs to support people who: 1) are involved in working in the area of child abuse and neglect in Canada; 2) may have the ability to take the benefits of this experience back to their communities; and 3) can offer local or regional training to others. Professional scholarships are \$500 while student scholarships are \$250.
